



Note: Information is changing on a near-daily basis; the below is as of March 25, 2020.

INCOME TAX DEADLINES

Federal Income Tax:

- Tax Return deadline moved from April 15th to July 15th
 - Individual income tax return – Form 1040
 - Trust and Estate income tax return – Form 1041
 - C Corporation income tax return – Form 1120
- Any income tax payments (including self-employment tax payments) due April 15th are now due July 15th.
 - Balance due on 2019 Federal Income Tax Return
 - First quarter income tax estimate for 2020
- **Second quarter income tax estimate for 2020 is still due June 15th.**
- No extension needs to be filed by April 15th. For example: can file extension by July 15th to extend due date of personal tax return to October 15th.

Other Payments:

- Retirement plan contributions normally due April 15th are now due July 15th. For example:
 - Individual Retirement Accounts (IRA) and Simplified Employee Pension Plan (SEP)
- Health Savings Account contributions normally due April 15th are now due July 15th.

Illinois Income Tax

- Same as Federal (see above) for
 - Filing Return Deadline and 2019 Balance Due payment
- Difference from Federal (see above) for
 - First quarter 2020 estimate – payment remains due April 15th
 - Second quarter 2020 estimate – payment remains due June 15th
