To Our HB Clients:

As a reminder, the Illinois first quarter estimate is still due April 15, even though the 2019 Illinois return (and any payment owing on that return) is due July 15. If your 2019 returns have been prepared, and you have an Illinois first quarter estimate, make sure it is paid by April 15.

If you do not have your 2019 returns prepared yet, and you think you will owe an Illinois first quarter estimate, please contact our office. We are still preparing, and processing returns and will continue to prepare as many as we can, if we have all the information needed. If not, Illinois is allowing us to use the “actual liability for year 2018” as a base for the 2020 first quarter estimate.

This explanation isn't entirely clear to us, but we will do our best to get an estimate tax voucher to everyone that needs it by April 15th.
